*Christmas Tree Recycling – Cayuga County Trade-A-Tree Program*

Cayuga Recycles, a program of the Cayuga County Planning Department, in conjunction with the Cayuga County Soil and Water Conservation District, is sponsoring the annual trade a tree program in Cayuga County. Bring in your “used” (real) Christmas tree after the holidays, and we will give you a certificate for a tree seedling to be picked up in the spring! Old trees will be chipped into mulch to be used on county projects, rather than taking up space in landfills. A Canaan Fir transplant will be given out to anyone who redeems their certificate on May 6, 2016, at the Annual District Tree & Shrub Sale.

Trees must be free of decorations, tinsel, wraps or any other foreign objects. Trees will be accepted at the Natural Resource Center, 7413 County House Road, Auburn, NY during the following hours:

January 4-8, 2016 -8 AM – 4 PM  
January 11-15, 2016 - 8 AM – 4 PM
