

AWARD RESOLUTION # 100 of 2014

**AWARDING THE SOUTH STREET REPAVING PROJECT
TO RIZZO CONSTRUCTION**

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2014 the Auburn City Council approved Council Resolution #49 authorizing permission to advertise for bids for the South Street Repaving Project PIN #374458; and

WHEREAS, this project is included in the New York State 5-Year Capital Plan and the eligible portion of the project will be reimbursed 80% by Federal Highway Funds, 15% New York State Marchiselli Funds with a local share of 5%; and

WHEREAS, the Project includes the installation of a new water main, the milling and repaving of the road along South Street from Lincoln Street to Metcalf Drive and will also include sidewalks and curbing, street lighting and traffic signals as needed ; and

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2014 bids were opened for this project and the following bids were received:

WHEREAS, F. Rizzo Construction, Inc. was the low bidder in the amount of \$3,018,900 and it is necessary for the Auburn City Council to award that low bid, all of which is contingent upon New York State Department of Transportation approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Auburn City Council does hereby award the South Street Repaving Project to F. Rizzo Construction, Inc. of Auburn, New York in

the amount of \$3,018,900, subject to and contingent upon approval of the New York State Department of Transportation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the cost of which \$1,395,425 shall be charged to Account #HF 8340-440-EW for water line work which is not eligible for reimbursement, and \$1,623,475 is to be charged to Account #HA 5110-440-GO which is eligible for 95% reimbursement.
