AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH CONESTOGA-ROVERS & ASSOCIATES FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT SUPERVISORY CONTROL AND DATA ACQUISITION SYSTEM (SCADA) SYSTEM PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn has undertaken a project to make improvements to the City's wastewater treatment plant including the overflow retention facility and the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition System (SCADA) as required under the Consent Order issued on August 6, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements and equipment upgrades to the City's wastewater treatment plant are technical in nature and requires professional engineering expertise; and

WHEREAS, by way of Award Resolution No. 90 of 2012, the Auburn City Council awarded professional engineering services related to design reports and technical assistance for the wastewater treatment plant improvements to Conestoga-Rovers & Associates (CRA) in the amount of \$540,400; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide a Supplemental Agreement in an amount up to \$55,400 to cover additional engineering services related to the implementation of SCADA and coordination with wastewater treatment plant equipment systems.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Auburn, New York, that it does hereby authorize the Mayor to execute a supplemental professional engineering services agreement with CRA of Buffalo, New York at a cost not to exceed \$55,400 to be charged to the Overflow Retention/SCADA project Capital Account (#HG 8230 440 GQ).
