The City of Auburn is conducting an open house public informational meeting on Wednesday September 2, 2015 between 3:00 pm and 7:00 pm in Council Chambers at Memorial City Hall, 24 South Street, Auburn, NY 13021 to discuss the upcoming Locally Administered Federal Aid paving project. The purpose of the meeting is to obtain input and comments from individuals, groups, businesses, officials, and local agencies. The City is specifically soliciting comments on the project's social, economic, and environmental effects.

The project consists of milling and resurfacing 1.7 miles of Genesee Street between Bluefield Road (West City Line) and North Street (NYS Route 34/38). In addition to the pavement rehabilitation work, sidewalk curb ramps and signals will be upgraded to be ADA compliant and improve safety. Bicycle accommodations within the existing curb width will be investigated through the use of shared use lanes delineated by signs and pavement markings and/or dedicated bicycle lanes through possible travel lane reconfiguration. Traffic is planned to be maintained on-site during construction.
