**REAL.** The City of Auburn (pop. 27,000) is situated at the north end of Owasco Lake within the Finger Lakes Wine Region - a top 5 international tourism destination. Auburn is a full service small city with a budget in excess of \$30 million. The City offers full-time police and fire service, curbside trash and recycling pickup, parks and recreation staffing, and much more. Auburn's downtown is thriving; efforts are underway to design and build a trail along the Owasco River through the heart of downtown.

**SMART.** Auburn is centrally located between two of Upstate New York's largest cities - Syracuse and Rochester. Cayuga Community College (<http://www.cayuga-cc.edu>) located on the City's east side provides an affordable gateway to higher education, credit-free courses and specialized workforce training. CayugaWorks Career Center, cited on that campus, includes multi-agency presence focused on workforce development. Nearly 50 higher education institutions are located within 60 miles of Auburn, including six community colleges and such top ranking schools as Cornell University, Rochester Institute of Technology, and Syracuse University. Primary education in Auburn includes a mix of both public and private opportunities.

The City's largest employment sectors include advanced manufacturing, education and health care, government, transportation and utilities, and leisure and hospitality. The City's largest employers include Auburn Armature (electrical distributor and repair), (Currier Plastics, EmCom (electro-mechanical components), Hammond & Irving (forged metal rings), McQuay International (HVAC systems), MEDENT (medical record systems) and NUCOR Steel (Bar Mill). Auburn Community Hospital ([www.AuburnHospital.org](http://www.AuburnHospital.org)) is also a major employer and offers a full range of inpatient and outpatient services, state-of-the-art medical, surgical, and rehabilitation technologies.
