Re: Burglary Arrest

On August 18, 2015 at approximately 0943 hrs the Auburn Police Department received a report of a burglary in progress at a residence in the City of Auburn. A witness reported that a person was removing a television from the aforementioned residence and the witness provided a description of the suspect, as well as the vehicle utilized by the suspect.

A search of the surrounding area was conducted by the Auburn Police Dept. patrol division and the suspect was located and detained shortly after the report was received.

The investigation into the burglary resulted in a determination that the suspect, Randy A. Grader 14 Hillside Terrace Auburn, NY had stolen a 55" flat screen television from the victim's residence. The Auburn Police recovered the television and tools used to gain access to the victim's residence.

Randy Grader was subsequently arrested and charged with the below listed charges, and held pending arraignment.
