**Re: Disseminating Arrest**

The Auburn Police Detective Bureau reports the arrest of twenty three year old Fredy Alvarez Jr. of 395 Fountain Ave Brooklyn, NY. Fredy Alvarez was arrested today on a warrant for Disseminating Indecent Material to a Minor, 1<sup>st</sup> Degree (D Felony), and Endangering the Welfare of a Child (A Misdemeanor).

The investigation stems from a complaint filed earlier this spring by the victim's parent, after she met Alvarez. Alvarez had allegedly befriended her then fourteen year old daughter, claiming to be a 16yoa male. The parent met Alvarez in person at a local establishment with her daughter and determined he was actually twenty two years old. She then discovered that Alvarez had sent obscene photographs to her daughter, and traveled from the NYC area to meet her.

The investigation determined that the obscene images and texts had been sent to the teenager over a month and a half span beginning in April 2014. As a result of the investigation a warrant was applied for and approved by Auburn City Court.

Alvarez was located at his residence in Brooklyn, NY by members of the USMS, who transferred custody of Alvarez, to APD members at a predetermined location, so as to facilitate his return to Auburn.

Upon his return he was processed on the above charges and arraigned in Auburn City Court. Alvarez was remanded to CCJ in lieu of \$10,000/20,000.
