City Announces NYSDOT Road Project North St from Seymour St to the North City Line in Plans

Auburn NY April 13, 2010 - - The City of Auburn Engineering Department reports that The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) has scheduled two construction projects within the City of Auburn to be completed this year. The NYSDOT will be milling and repaving **North Street from Seymour St to the north City Line** as a temporary measure to improve the street's condition. A total reconstruction of the street from Routes 5 & 20 to the north City Line is currently in the NYSDOT's planning stage with a preliminary construction date of 2015. The NYSDOT will also be rehabilitating pedestrian facilities (paths, sidewalks, crosswalks, etc.) for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). This work will be along Route 5 (the East - West Arterial) from Columbus St / N. Division St to Seymour St.

The City is also in the process of examining city streets to identify those streets that will be recommended to City Council for paving as part of the City's 2010 Road Program.

In addition, the City's Department of Public Works is announcing a new way to report potholes. Citizens who would like to report a pothole can visit the City's Website ci.auburn.ny.us and use the **CONTACT US** link on the home page.
