“WE SHALL NEVER FORGET” 9/11 Remembrance Weekend – 10 Year Anniversary Auburn, New York

September 11, 2011 will mark 10 years since the terrorist attacks at the World Trade Center in New York; at the Pentagon in Northern Virginia; and at the crash site of United Flight 93 in Shanksville, Pennsylvania, killing nearly 3,000 people.
