### ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the furnishing of all labor and material necessary for the City of Auburn Landfill Transfer Station will be received by the City Engineer, Memorial City Hall, 24 South Street, Auburn, New York 13021 until 11:00 A.M. local time July 19, 2019 at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bids will be received for the following Contract:

Contract No. 1 – General Construction:

- Demolition and removal of existing paved and concrete surfaces;
- Installation of pile system building support;
- Fill placement and excavation within and around transfer station building area;
- Construction of transfer station building; and
- Installation of leachate conveyance infrastructure and underground utilities.

Contract Documents, including Advertisement For Bids, Information For Bidders, Labor and Employment, Additional Instructions, Bid Documents, Agreement, General Conditions, General Requirements, Specifications, Contract Drawings and any Addenda, may be examined at no expense at the office of Barton & Loguidice, D.P.C., 443 Electronics Parkway, Liverpool, New York 13088. ALL HANDLING COSTS (MAIL, DELIVERY SERVICES, ETC.) SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE BIDDER.

Each bid must be accompanied by security in an amount not less than five percentum (5%) of the amount of the bid in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders. No Bidder may withdraw his bid within forty-five (45) days after the actual date of opening thereof.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at the City of Auburn Landfill, 311 North Division Street, Auburn, New York 13021 on June 27, 2019 at 10:00 A.M. This conference will commence with a review of any questions that potential Bidders may have. Upon completion of the question period, the conference will proceed with a site walkover. Any questions requiring clarification will be addressed in an Addendum.

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This is an exempt capital improvement project, and Bidders shall not include in their Bid sales and compensating use taxes on the cost of materials which are to be incorporated into the work and which are to be separately sold by the Contractor to the City of Auburn prior to incorporation into the work of the Contract.

The attention of Bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract.

The right is reserved to waive any informalities in the Bid and to reject any or all Bids.
