


## **CURB CUT SPECIFICATION SHEET**

- 1. Owner shall construct new curb and/or approach in accordance with the City of Auburn Engineering specifications.
- 2. Owner shall provide the following information on the attached sketch (page 2 of the application):
  - a. Dimensions of proposed approach to trees, property lines, building, hydrants, utility poles, etc. (see example sketch).
  - b. North arrow.
  - c. House location and number.
  - d. Curb cut location and length requested with proximity of adjacent physical features (trees, utility poles, catch basins, etc. as shown on example sketch).
  - e. Existing walk (if any).
  - f. Existing driveway (if any).
  - g. Street name
  - h. Property lines and corner markers (where possible).
- 3. Roadway shall be reconstructed to as good or better than pre-construction condition.
- 4. Final approval of material and slope of driveway approach must be obtained from the City Engineer before commencing construction.
- 5. When driveway approach is not installed at the time of curb-cut construction, owner shall beck-fill curb sufficiently to prevent settlement.
- 6. Owner must install 8" concrete sidewalk across driveway in accordance with City of Auburn Municipal Code.
