

# Got Sharps?

Needles, syringes, lancets and other sharp health care products **should NEVER be recycled**. They may be contaminated and pose a danger to recycling workers. They can also cause costly delays and equipment malfunctions during the recycling process.



## TO PROPERLY DISPOSE OF SHARPS:

1. Place sharps in a puncture-proof container with a tight fitting lid.
2. Label the container with your name, address and phone number.
3. Call one of the drop-off locations below to arrange for someone to meet you.
