












History

- 398 total spaces, which include 36 metered first floor spots
- This section will transition from individual meters to a walk up pay station

Operations

- A5651 Municipal Parking \$136,348
- Some crossover with APD's enforcement staff
- Automating the pay system and eliminating the 4 part time positions
- Creating one full time laborer position to maintain facility and assist the welcome center, parks, downtown, etc.
- Reducing payroll costs by approximately \$35,000 per year and gaining full time maintenance effort

Automation

- Cost approximately \$90,000

- Payback approximately 3 years based on reduction in payroll expense
- Possibly shorter payback duration if revenue increases with extended pay to park hours







Automation Benefits

- Mobile staff on site the majority of daylight hours
- Automation allows for any business to validate parking
- Set up through the internet and each business will pay for the validation through the ticket number
- Can issue Access Cards for entry and exit with specific parameters: Monday-Friday, 7am-6pm only, weekends only, designated total of entrances and exits per month, etc.

Automation Benefits, cont.

- Can control parking for 24 hours per day if desired
- Reduces overhead
- Accurate car counts and usage data
- Daily comprehensive audits for cash collection and reconciliation
- Increases garage maintenance effort and productivity
