### Introduction

- General fund (\$34,257,715); 1% inc over 2018:
  - Draft gap was ~\$560,000
  - Tax Increase of ~4.70%
  - Balanced without the use of fund balance
  - In general compliance with the five year plan
  - In compliance with the state tax cap

### General Fund Items of Note - Expenditures

- Corporation Counsel Personnel Changes
- Engineering Personnel Changes
- Unallocated Salaries Decrease
- Code Enforcement Personnel Changes
- City Manager & Planning Personnel Changes

### General Fund Items of Note - Expenditures

- Health Insurance Consortium & new CBAs
- Transfers to Other Funds
  - Capital Decrease
  - Power Utility Fund Increase
- Contractual Salary and Wage Increases

### General Fund – Revenues

- Property Taxes: 4.70% increase
- Property Tax Cap Margin
- Sales Tax 3.75% increase over PY budget
- PILOT reduced by \$150,000

### Water and Sewer Funds

- Sewer Fund
  - Balanced with a small use of fund balance
  - No general rate increases

- Water Fund
  - Balanced without use of fund balance
  - No rate increases

### Other Funds

- Solid-Waste Fund
  - Balanced on a cash flow basis
- Refuse Collection Fund
  - Balanced with small use of fund balance
  - No fee changes
- Power Utility Fund
  - Balanced on as cash flow basis
  - General fund transfer
  - N. Division Street Hydro Active December 2017
  - LFGE remains in mothballed status
