Service or Operational Changes

Planning & Economic Development

 2018/19 Health Insurance under budgeted -Operating budget increase is approx. 3.4% when adjusted for discrepancy

Code Enforcement

- Plumbing Inspector moved to Municipal Utilities
- Property Clean-up Program Two (2) part-time Laborer positions to two (2) full-time Code Enforcement Laborer positions
- Code Enforcement software expenses moved from Central Services budget to Code Enforcement budget



<u>Initial</u> <u>Department</u> <u>Requests</u>

- Planning & Economic Development
 - Historic District Project \$15,000
- Code Enforcement
 - Vehicles (Dump Truck) \$58,000
 - Other Equipment (Tractor) \$33,500 (reduced to \$5,000 for other equipment needs)
 - Software \$84,800 (reduced to \$50,000)
 - Housing Code Update \$75,000
 - Demolition \$100,000 (reduced to \$50,000)
