

COUNCIL RESOLUTION #29 OF 2022

AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT PURSUANT TO THE 2022 CITY OF AUBURN PROCUREMENT AND SURPLUS POLICY

WHEREAS, on January 6, 2022, the City Council of the City of Auburn passed Council Resolution No. 4 of 2022, which adopted a City of Auburn Procurement and Surplus Policy (the “Procurement Policy”); and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Policy requires that the sale of surplus vehicles and equipment with an estimated value of \$1,000 or more be approved by City Council; and

WHEREAS, a list of City owned surplus vehicles, equipment, and other items, which have outlived their useful life or are no longer necessary or useful to the City, are attached hereto in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to dispose of the equipment and vehicles set forth in Exhibit A through a direct sale with Milton Cat in order to obtain the best value for them.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Auburn hereby authorizes the sale of the City-owned vehicles and equipment set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto in accordance with the 2022 City of Auburn Procurement and Surplus Policy.
