WHEREAS, the members of emergency medical services teams engage in thousands of hours of specialized training and continuing education to enhance their lifesaving skills; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Week theme for 2022 is Rising to the Challenge and it is an appropriate theme to recognize the value and the accomplishments of the integration of the new Auburn City Ambulance into our City of Auburn organization over the past 12 months; and
