The mural across the street depicts Harriet Tubman's life from the Civil War through her 54 years in Auburn, New York, her chosen hometown. Tubman is buried in Fort Hill Cemetery in Auburn.

The mural project was spearheaded by the Harriet Tubman Boosters, a non-profit organization dedicated to honoring the life of Harriet Tubman and preserving her legacy for generations to come.

The mural was funded by grants, corporate donations, and over 200 individual donors in 13 states and Canada.
