#### **Application for Restore NY Grant Round 8**

The City intends to apply to Empire State Development (ESD) for funding through the Restore NY Communities Initiatives and is required to hold a Public Hearing to solicit public comment regarding the Grant application and Property Assessment List. The City is applying for approximately \$2,000,000 in grant funds to assist with the rehabilitation of 120 Genesee Street (a 3-story commercial structure located in the Auburn BID). **The Public Hearing will be held on Thursday, May 9, 2024, 5:00 pm, at the regularly scheduled City Council Meeting, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Memorial City Hall, 24 South Street, Auburn, NY.**
