Update on Air Quality Alert for Cayuga County

At the time of this release, the outdoor air quality level for Cayuga County is now Unhealthy on the Air Quality Index (AQI) scale.

People with heart or lung disease, older adults, children and teens – take any of these steps to reduce your exposure:

- Avoid strenuous outdoor activities.
- Keep outdoor activities short.
- Consider moving physical activities indoors or rescheduling them.

Everyone else – take any of these steps to reduce your exposure:

- Choose less strenuous activities (like walking instead of running) so you don't breathe as hard.
- Shorten the amount of time you are active outdoors.
- Be active outdoors when air quality is better.
