On 07-17-2200 at approximately 1937 hours, following an investigation into the illegal possession of dangerous substances and guns, a search warrant that was issued by the Honorable Thomas Leone out of Cayuga County Court, was executed at 8 Delevan St. in the City of Auburn by the Finger Lakes Drug Task Force with assistance from the Auburn Police Department, the Auburn Police Department Emergency response Team (APD ERT), and the New York State Police Troop E Violent Gang Narcotics Enforcement Team (NYSP VGNET).

A loaded 9mm "ghost" handgun, a small amount of synthetic drugs called "molly", scales, and a small amount of US currency was recovered from the garage area of the residence being occupied as a living area by Scott A. Corey Sr. Scott A. Corey Sr. (05-08-77) was arrested and charged with Criminal possession of a Weapon in the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree (C Felony), Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3<sup>rd</sup> degree (D felony), Criminal Possession of a Firearm (E Felony), and Possession or Sale of a Mislabeled Dangerous Substance (Misdemeanor)

The Cayuga County District Attorney's Office will prosecute the case.
