On June 2nd, 2021 at about 12:24 AM the Auburn Police Department were dispatched to a noise complaint of subjects arguing at 19 Franklin St. in the City of Auburn. Upon patrols arrival the defendant Victor S. Houston attempted to flee from the scene on foot before being detained by patrolmen. During the course of the investigation it was determined that the defendant was in possession of an assault rifle that had a defaced serial number that was found at the scene. The defendant was charged with 3 counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon. Houston was processed and held pending his arraignment.
