- **William Lupien** is superintendent of engineering services for the City of Auburn, and will share the 16 years of experience of Memorial City Hall's geothermal system.
- **New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA) experts** will discuss their Clean Heating and Cooling program as well as other relevant commercial building programs.
