On May 27, 2019 at 2:44 p.m., Patrol Officers were dispatched to the area of Washington St on an investigation. During the investigation, an officer attempted to make an arrest of an 18 year old Auburn resident after being physically pushed in the chest. The defendant did further resist their arrest by kicking at the officer and the defendant did bite the right index finger of the officer as he was attempting to gain control of the defendant. While placing the 18 year old under arrest, 20 year old codefendant Destiny Gould did slap the officer in the face in an attempt to prevent the arrest of the 18 year old. Both subjects were eventually taken into to custody.

The officer sustained a bite wound to his right index finger that required treatment at Auburn Community Hospital. The officer was treated for a laceration and bruising and was released from ACH. Both defendants were arraigned on this date at Auburn City Court.

The 18 year old defendant was charged with the following:

- \*1 count of assault in the second degree, a class D Felony
- \*1 count of Obstructing Governmental Administration 2<sup>nd</sup> degree, Class A Misdemeanor

Destiny M. Gould who is a 20 year old Auburn resident was charged with the following:

- \*1 count of Obstructing Governmental Administration 2<sup>nd</sup> degree, Class A Misdemeanor
  - \*1 count of harassment in the second degree, Violation
