On 08-29-2020 at approximately 2023 hours, following an investigation into the illegal possession of dangerous substances, narcotics, and guns; a search warrant that was issued by the Honorable Thomas Leone out of Cayuga County Court, was executed at 2 Arch St. in the City of Auburn by the Finger Lakes Drug Task Force with assistance from the Auburn Police Department.

A loaded .22 cal handgun, a loaded .22 cal bolt action rifle, over ½ oz of fentanyl or methamphetamine compound, scales, packaging material, and a small amount of US currency was recovered from the person and residence of Paul B. Bovee.

Paul B. Bovee (12-28-87) was arrested and charged with Menacing a Police Officer (D Fel) Criminal possession of a Weapon in the 2nd degree (C Fel), Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3rd degree (D Fel), Criminal Possession of a Firearm (E Felony), Criminal Possession Controlled Substance 3rd Degree (B Fel), Criminal Possession Weapon 4th Degree (Mis), 2 Counts Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia 2nd degree (Mis) and Obstructing Governmental Administration 2nd Degree (Mis).

The Cayuga County District Attorney's Office will prosecute the case.
