Cayuga County COVID-19 Situational Update as of 5:45pm

A Cayuga County resident who was formerly hospitalized passed away Tuesday, October 6, 2020. This resident tested positive for COVID-19 toward the beginning of their hospitalization. Due to the positive test and hospitalization, the Health Department continued to monitor this individual. The resident was a gentleman in his sixties with underlying chronic medical conditions. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and his family, we will not be releasing further information.

New cases
