Hospitalized patients

One hospitalized Cayuga County resident at this time.

Confirmed Cases – total year to date

There have been a total of 93 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Cayuga County.

Discharges- total year to date

There have been 75 individuals discharged from Mandatory Isolation.

Deaths

One death related to COVID-19 in our county.

Test Results Received –

Number of test results received since testing began in early March – 3,865 as of today.

- This information includes all testing of Cayuga County residents by physicians, healthcare facilities and licensed clinical laboratories.

Results pending – As of today, we are awaiting the results of 110 tests that were performed on Cayuga County residents by the Cayuga County Health Department, physicians, health care facilities and clinical laboratories.
