Updated information

On Friday July 10th, one new case was identified with contact tracing underway. The contact tracing is now complete.

Saturday, July 11, 2020 – no new cases

A Cayuga County resident who was hospitalized and had tested positive for COVID-19, has passed away. The decedent, a male in his 60's had been hospitalized with underlying chronic health issues which may have contributed to his death. Out of respect for the privacy of the deceased and his family, we will not be releasing further information.
