UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

- Devices containing mercury (thermostats, light bulbs, lamps, etc.)
- · Household hazardous waste
- Devices containing refrigerant (A/C units, water coolers,dehumidifiers,refrigerators,winechillers,etc.)
- · Broken/bare CRT (tube) TVs or monitors
- Materials containing liquids
- Radioactive materials (smoke detectors)
- Devices containing PCBs (ballasts from light fixtures must clearly state "No PCBs")
- Gas powered equipment
- Large appliances (i.e. stoves, washing

machines, dryers, dishwashers)

- Paper for shredding
- Common household batteries (i.e. AAA, AA, C, D, button cell, NiCad tool batteries)
- Damaged, defective, recalled, swollen, burned, or leaking batteries
- · CDs, DVDs, VHS tapes, and cassette tapes
- · Remanufactured/off-brand/generic toner
- Medical Sharps
