

Are You Owed Rent due to COVID-19?



Emergency Rental Assistance is on its way.

Your tenant qualifies if

An individual in the household has qualified for unemployment benefits or experienced a reduction in household income, incurred significant cost, or experienced other financial hardship due to COVID-19;

An individual in the household can demonstrate a risk of experiencing homelessness or housing instability; and

The household has a household income at or below 80% of the area median income.

If your tenant qualifies

Landlords may receive rent and utility arrears payments of up to 12 months and prospective rent payments of up to 3 months.

Limited funds available.

Arrears that have accrued before March 13, 2020 cannot be paid with these funds. Landlords may receive funds for former renters, if eligible.

Mobile home and lot rent and utility payments are eligible for assistance.
