City to Mark the Completion of Phase I of the Owasco River Greenway Trail with Ribbon Cutting Ceremony

Mayor Quill and the members of the City Council invite the public to celebrate the completion of Phase I of the Owasco River Greenway Trail project with a ribbon cutting ceremony to be held:

Date, time: Thursday, May 30, 2019 at 7 p.m.

Location: at the new Owasco River Overlook on Loop Road by Genesee Street.

Construction on the Owasco River Greenway Trail Project Phase I began in the spring of 2018. The project boundaries include the Downtown portion of the trail from State Street going east to the Mill Street Dam. The project was funded with a compilation of the following State and Federal funding sources: a Federal Highway Administration grant through the Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery, or "TIGER II" program; a NYS DOT Transportation Enhancement Program (TEP) grant; and, entitlement funds from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).

Earlier that evening at the weekly City Council meeting City staff will present a recap of the project and its history. The City Council meeting begins at 6 p.m. and will be held at Memorial City Hall, 24 South Street, Auburn.
