Re: Missing Person

The Auburn Police Department is requesting assistance from the public in locating missing 14-year-old Kiley Deuel-Murray. Kiley voluntarily left her residence on Owasco Street on 09/11/2023 and is refusing to return. Kiley has been in contact with her family, but they do not know her whereabouts. Kiley is around 5’ tall, 110 lbs, blue eyes, and could have dyed her hair.

It is believed that person(s) may be assisting Kiley in avoiding being located or returned to her family. Any attempt to conceal or assist a missing juvenile in order to prevent that juvenile from being located and safely returned home is a criminal offense. Charges will be sought against anyone attempting to conceal Kiley or assist her in avoiding return to her home.
