On April 26, 2020 at approximately 1956 Hrs members of the Auburn Police Department were dispatched to 297 Grant Ave., Walmart, for a robbery investigation. It was originally reported that a white male, wearing a burgundy hat and sweatshirt with shoulder length dark hair forcibly stole a quantity of jewelry from the jewelry case. Upon stealing the jewelry the suspect ran out of the store using a rear exit. A perimeter was established and patrol officers, assisted by the Cayuga County Sheriff's Officer and NYSP, conducted a search of the area with negative results. At this time the Auburn Police Department is looking for the public's assistance attempting to identify the male in the attached photo.
