On Friday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at approximately 11:35 P.M., members of the Auburn Police Department responded to the area of Holley St. located in the city of Auburn for a reported "shots fired" complaint. Several calls were made to Cayuga County E-911 by residents living in the area who described hearing what they believed to be several gunshots and then what sounded like a vehicle speeding off and leaving the area at a high rate of speed.

Upon responding officer's arrival to the area, officers were able identify and secure a scene. Based on the evidence located at the scene, it was determined there had been several rounds fired from a firearm. Several of the rounds struck a residence located in the area of Holley St. There were no reported injuries.

At this time this appears to be an isolated incident and is not related to the most recent shots fired-death on Perrine St. The investigation is ongoing and anyone with information regarding this incident is requested to call the Auburn Police Department at 315-253-3231 or email <a href="mailto:communitywatch@auburnny.gov">communitywatch@auburnny.gov</a>.
