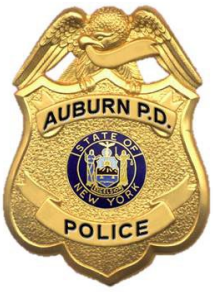

On July 26, 2022 at approximately 3:00 am Officer Young was on-duty in the area of Orchard Street, when a vehicle drove by him plating unreasonably loud music. As Officer Young approached this vehicle, the driver began driving at a high rate of in an apparent attempt to elude the officer. The operator, later identified as Garlyn Gause, passed a stop sign on Pine Street @ Clark Street without stopping.

Officer Young then initiated a traffic stop. Gause failed to comply with the traffic stop and proceeded to attempt to elude the officer. The vehicle was followed by APD officers as Gause continued onto John Street, then onto Owasco Street, and then finally stopping on Miller Street where he then fled on foot. A foot pursuit ensued from Miller Street to Mill Street. Gause began jumping fences and hid behind shrubbery near Owasco Street where Officer Parker and Officer Young arrested Gause in front of 67 Owasco Street after a brief struggle.

During the events of this police interaction with Gause, the officers recovered eighty-five individually packaged glassine envelopes containing heroin. Also recovered were seven baggies containing cocaine. Based on the quantity of drugs, Gause was charged with two felony counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled substance in the Third degree.

The Finger Lakes Drug Task Force assisted along with the Cayuga County Sheriff's Office.
