On June 16, 2021 at approximately 7:14 am the Auburn Police Department and the Auburn Fire Department were dispatched to McDonald's (Grant Ave.) for a report of a male hit by a vehicle while in the parking lot. Upon arrival an elderly male pedestrian was found to have been hit by a vehicle. The operator of the vehicle was administering aid to the pedestrian upon arrival.

The pedestrian was transported to University Upstate Hospital for additional treatment. His condition as of this media release is currently unknown and will not be released at this time.

The McDonald's was closed temporarily until approximately 9:00 am as officers examined the scene.

No further information is being released at this time as the investigation is still developing and information / evidence is still being analyzed in order to make an accurate determination.
