On May 04, 2019 at 11:03am Patrol Officers from the Auburn Police Department were dispatched to 136 Dunning Ave. on a report of a female being held against her will by a male holding a knife in the basement of the residence. Upon arrival Officers were able to enter the residence and remove all persons without incident. Darryl W. Nottage was located at the residence in possession of a knife commonly used by hunters for field dressing animals. Upon further investigation officers were advised that Nottage was engaged in an argument with the female victim at which time he punched the victim in the head and threatened her with the knife. Nottage was taken into custody and charged with:
