On June 16th, 2022 at about 7:03 PM members of Auburn Police Department were dispatched to a complaint involving a possible suspect carrying a hand gun near State St. near Auburn Prison. The complainant stated that there were two males one with a hand gun walking towards to Perrine St. from State St.. The 911 callers stated the suspect removed the hand gun from his waist band and then placed it back in the area of his waist band.

Auburn Police Officers then converged in the area of State St. near Perrine St.. Witnesses stated the two males entered a residence in the area of Perrine St. near State St.. Officers then surrounded the residence and set up a perimeter. At this time Auburn Police Officers attempted to make contact with the residents inside the house, but initially with negative results. After approximately thirty to forty minutes contact was made with the occupants inside the house. Negotiations furthered and the occupants exited the residence without further incident.

Auburn Police Department was then given consent to search to the residence. During the search two pellet hand guns were located inside and collected as evidence. Both guns appeared to be realistic in nature.

The Auburn Police Department would like to thank the New York State Police, and the Cayuga County 911. We would also like to thank the many bar patrons for following directions during a hectic scenario where no one was hurt. We know there were multiple rumors of hostage situation, shots fired, and active shooter, but none were true.
