On 01/25/2021 at about 10:30 AM the Auburn Police Department was dispatched to the area of Generations Bank, 10 Osborne St, for a report of an unconscious male.

Upon arrival, several citizens were performing CPR on an unresponsive male subject who was laying on the sidewalk near the entrance to Generations Bank. Members of Auburn Fire Department and TLC Ambulance took over resuscitation attempts and transported the male to Auburn Community Hospital.

At Auburn Community Hospital, the male was subsequently identified as a 52 year old resident of Auburn, and unfortunately pronounced dead after resuscitation attempts were unsuccessful. *(The victim's identity will not be released at this time as this matter is not believed to be suspicious in nature)*

The Auburn Police Department is looking for information from anyone who may have seen the male in the area of Generations Bank/Wegmans. The male is described as a heavyset white male who was wearing a dark brown Corduroy jacket and blue jeans, carrying a blue reusable bag.

Autopsy results are pending and the investigation is ongoing.
