**Assemble at 10:30 AM- Move out at 11:00 AM SHARP  
Parade Route is West on East Genesee Street to Veteran's Memorial Park**

**IMPORTANT REMINDERS!**

- 1. Please remember the occasion is Memorial Day. Floats and vehicles must be decorated in the theme of honoring Memorial Day.**
- 2. Distribution of any literature is strictly prohibited.**
- 3. There is no politicking allowed during the parade. This includes campaigning of any sort.**
- 4. For the safety of attendees, there is to be no throwing of candy from cars or floats. If you want to distribute candy it must be done by people walking along the side of your vehicle at the edge of the crowd.**
- 5. The Parade takes approximately ONE HOUR from start to finish.**
- 6. Please bring a drink with you!**
- 7. Please bring sunscreen, umbrella, poncho, etc. as necessary based on weather conditions.**
- 8. There are no bathrooms available along the parade route. There are porto-johns located at the end of the parade route in the parking lot of the Cayuga County office building.**
- 9. The Parade ends at Veteran's Memorial Park, however, groups MUST carry on and make a right onto James Street before leaving formation, breaking down floats or being picked up.**
