## Media Release

Date/ Time of Release: May 06, 2020 1:30 p.m.

Location of Event Occurrence: Jefferson St. near Orchard St.

Nature of Event: Shots Fired

On May 05, 2020 at approximately 11:40 p.m. members of the Auburn Police Department were dispatched to a Jefferson St. residence near the intersection of Orchard St. for a report of a female discharging a handgun. Upon arrival officers determined that the female suspect had fired 3 rounds into the air and then fled the scene in a black sedan. No one was injured during the incident and it appears the confrontation stemmed from a prior domestic incident at the same location.

Further investigation revealed that Morgan Ferraraccio, a 29 year old, of Auburn was the suspect in the incident. Ferraraccio was located a short time later and subsequently charged with reckless endangerment 2<sup>nd</sup> degree and discharging a firearm within 500 feet of a dwelling, both misdemeanors. Ferraraccio was released on an appearance ticket to appear in Auburn City Court. The handgun used has been recovered by police.
