The Auburn Police Department announces the arrest of Patrick E. Jackson of Auburn on February 3, 2019. Mr. Jackson was the subject of a lengthy investigation after the child victim accused Mr. Jackson of repeated sexual abuse. A search warrant was executed at Mr. Jackson's apartment and several cell phones and computers were seized as evidence. The computers were forensically analyzed by the New York State Police Computer Crimes Unit and at least one image of a child engaged in sexual conduct was found on Mr. Jackson's computers. Patrick Jackson was charged with Course of sexual conduct against a child in the first degree which is a Class B felony and possessing a sexual performance by a child which is a Class E felony. Additionally, Mr. Jackson was charged with Endangering the welfare of a child, a Class A misdemeanor. Mr. Jackson was located by APD members in conjunction with the U.S. Marshals felony warrant detail. Mr. Jackson was arraigned in Auburn City Court and remanded to the Cayuga County Jail.
