On April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at approximately 9:24 pm, members of the Auburn Police Department responded to the area of Wall Street and Derby Avenue to the report of shots fired complaint in which there are no known injuries.

At approximately 10:59 pm, officers responded to the area of Frazee Street and Canoga Road to a similar complaint in which the outside of a residence was struck multiple times by gunfire. During the incident no one was injured.
