The Auburn Police Department have been receiving numerous calls regarding the credit card skimming device located at Walmart in the City of Auburn. One of the questions is in regards to what terminal or lane the device was located. It has been confirmed that the device was located by Walmart staff in terminal #2 on July 5th. The device was installed on Sunday July 2nd at approximately 8:00AM.

If you purchased anything at Walmart and know that you used terminal #2 between July 2nd, 2023 and July 5th, 2023, please check your banking history and contact your bank so that your bank can take necessary actions to protect your account. If you purchased something at Walmart between July 2nd, 2023 and July 5th, 2023 but cannot remember which terminal you used, the Auburn Police Department recommends you check your bank account history and contact your bank so that they can take actions to protect your account.

After these steps are taken and you confirm or suspect that you are a victim of the skimming device then please contact the Auburn Police Department at 315-253-3231 to report the fraud and reference this incident.
