Testing for COVID-19 for Workers

A clinic is scheduled for essential workers and employees returning to work under Phase 1 of reopening, to be tested for COVID-19. This is the nasopharyngeal viral testing swab, not the antibody test.

Essential workers include, **but are not limited to:** grocery store, convenience and hardware store employees, restaurant workers, first responders, law enforcement, correction officers, healthcare providers. Phase 1 employees include those working in: construction, agriculture, forestry, fishing, hunting, retail workers, manufacturing and wholesale trade.

This clinic is also open to household members of these workers and employees, including children ages two and older.

The Cayuga County Health Department will be offering a drive-thru COVID-19 clinic on:

- **Friday, May 22, 2020 from 1:00pm – 4:00pm**
- The drive-thru clinic is **by appointment only**.
