Memorial Day is a day when Americans reflect on the sacrifice of those women and men who have given their lives in military service to our country. The City of Auburn has a long tradition of honoring Memorial Day with the annual community parade and a ceremony following the parade at Veterans Memorial Park, please adhere to the following rules to maintain the intended decorum of Memorial Day and ensure the safety of the participants and the public attendees. We thank you in advance for your cooperation.

IMPORTANT MEMORIAL DAY PARADE RULES

1. Please remember the occasion is Memorial Day. Floats and vehicles must be decorated in the theme of honoring Memorial Day.
2. No distribution of any literature is allowed during the Memorial Day parade.
3. For the safety of children, no throwing of candy from cars or floats. If you want to distribute candy it must be done by people walking along the side of your vehicle at the edge of the crowd.
4. There is no politicking allowed during the parade. This includes campaigning of any sort. Absolutely no political campaign banners/signs/flags, no campaign clothing, no distribution of political campaign literature or paraphernalia will be permitted. Those aspiring to hold elected public office and elected officials are strongly encouraged to remember the occasion is Memorial Day.
5. Car clubs are permitted a *maximum* of ten (10) cars for entry in to the parade. Cars should be vintage, antique, classic and/or collector vehicles only.
6. For-profit businesses are permitted *no more than* two (2) vehicles for your individual business entry in to the parade. Please remember the occasion is Memorial Day and vehicles must be decorated in the theme of honoring Memorial Day.
7. The parade ends immediately west of Veteran's Memorial Park on Genesee Street, however, groups **MUST** carry on and make a right on to James Street before leaving formation, breaking down floats or being picked up.
