Suit-Kote will notify all residents with door hanger notifications stating that the road will need to be closed, and they require residents to stay parked in their driveways or on adjacent streets until the material has reached its approximately 2 hour cure time, after which the streets will be open for traffic.

Microsurfacing is a 2-step process which will require a second coat (overlay treatment) following the initial scratch coating which could be installed either the same day or the following day, weather permitting. Any planned work delays due to rain or other unforeseen circumstances will be rescheduled and the affected residents will be notified again.
