Introduction

- General fund (\$37,932,323)
- 3% increase over 2021 revised budget
 - Draft gap is ~\$1,353,371
 - Gap can be balanced with the use of fund balance
 - Total Tax Revenue increase ~3.3%
 - In compliance with the state tax cap
 - In general compliance with the five year plan

General Fund Items of Note - Expenditures

- Pension Costs
 - 25% increase for Police & Fire Retirement System
 - 11% increase for Employee Retirement System
- Salary and Wage Increases
 - Based on Contracts
- Health Insurance Consortium
 - 10% increase projected for preliminary figures

General Fund – Revenues

- Property Taxes: 3.3% increase or \$411k
 - Within Property Tax Cap Margin
- Sales Tax: 3.9% increase over 20 Actuals
- PILOTS: 4.3% increase or \$25k
- FEMA Reimbursements: \$635k
- Transfer from Capital: \$1M

Municipal Utilities Funds

- Power Utility Fund
 - Draft gap ~ \$357k
 - ~ \$300k debt service for Cogen
- Sewer Fund
 - Balanced without use of fund balance
 - No rate increases
- Water Fund
 - Draft gap ~ \$388k
 - Can be balanced with use of fund balance
 - Can be incrementally reduced with water rate increases

Other Funds

- Solid-Waste Fund
 - Draft gap ~ \$155k
 - Due to closing landfill and leachate transfer
- Refuse Collection Fund
 - Draft gap ~ \$447k
 - Possible rate increase to close gap?
- Transfer Station
 - Draft gap ~ \$419k
 - Possible rate increase to close gap?
