# COLD NOODLE SALAD



#### BEFORE YOU START. MAKE SURE YOU:

- 1. Ask an adult for help
- 2. Wash & dry your hands
- 3. Grab an apron & collect your ingredients



Yields 4 portions

- 1/2 lb Ramen noodles, cooked and cooled
- 1 cup Carrots, julienned
- 1/2 cup Bell peppers, julienned
- 1/2 cup Daikon, julienned
- 1/2 cup Greek onions, fine bias cut
- 1 tbsp Thai Basil, chiffonade
- 1 tbsp Mint, chiffonade

\*Common Food Allergens: Wheat gluten, soy, sesame

#### For the Dressing

- 1/4 cup Canola oil
- 1/2 cup Sesame oil
- 2 tbsp Seasoned rice vinegar
- 1tbsp Mirin
- 1 tbsp Soy sauce
- 1tbsp Sugar
- 1 tsp Garlic, minced
- 1 tsp Green onion, minced
- 1/4 tsp White pepper, ground
- Salt to taste

# **DIRECTIONS**

- 1. Combine rice vinegar, mirin, shoyu, sugar, ginger, garlic, onions, and white pepper in a mixing bowl; whisk together until the sugar dissolves.

  Continue to whisk and slowly drizzle in the canola oil, followed by the sesame oil to create an emulsification. Finish the dressing with salt to taste.
- 2. Put the cool noodles and cut vegetables in a mixing bowl and pour the dressing over gently toss to coat the noodles and vegetables.
- 3. Portion the noodle salad into four dishes and garnish with basil and mint.
