FOCUS AREAS AND POLICY PROPOSALS

- Continue efforts at community outreach and bridge building started well before this process.
- Work to Implement Body-Worn Cameras
- Continue to use no-knock search warrants only in narrowly tailored situations.
- Continued training with expanded focus on Diversity, Racial Bias and De-escalation Techniques.
- Work to expand the availability of Mobile Crisis Team services to a 24/7 structure.
- Make mental health support a routine part of officer training, supervision and discipline.
- Implementation of the principles contained in Right-to-Know Laws implemented in other municipalities.
- Continued use of School Resource Officers in Auburn Enlarged City School District schools with focus on school student/staff safety, mentoring and relationship building.
- Work to more clearly define the complaint process via the APD website and other public outlets of access.
- Continue outreach programs with a goal of encouraging young people in underrepresented communities to consider local law enforcement and public service as an available and favorable career choice “Grow our Own”.
